Why do you want to fit this part?

- To make the use of the front brake and clutch lever more comfortable without pinching your fingers when pulling the clutch.

This part fits on the following motorcycle:

- KTM 640/950/990 Adv

Part list:

- 1 x KTM Two-Finger Front Brake Lever
- 1 x KTM Two-Finger Clutch Lever

Tools needed:

- T25 Torx
- 8mm Spanner
- Flat Screwdriver



Fitment Instructions:

<p>Step 1: Remove the top screw of the brake lever using a T25 Torx and an 8mm spanner.</p>	
<p>Step 2: Pull or remove the standard lever outwards from the casing. Be careful not to lose the inside spring once removed.</p>	
<p>Step 3: Remove the back part (cap part) of the knob of the adjustment screw using a flat screwdriver. Wedge it between the cap and the lever.</p>	
<p>Step 4: Unscrew the adjuster from the original lever and install in Two-Finger Lever. Press back the adjuster knob.</p>	
<p>Step 5: Install the Two-Finger Lever using the T25 Torx and 8mm spanner as in Step 1.</p>

Step 6: Ensure all bolts are fastened and the brake lever set properly before riding.

Repeat Steps 1 to 6 for the Clutch Lever.

Please remember to fit the triangular spacer on the clutch lever as indicated on the small leaflet.

Note: If you feel that that the end of the Two-Finger Clutch Lever is touching your other fingers, move the mirror a few millimetres to the inside. This will ensure that you still have enough leverage but will shorten the lever a bit more.



Note: Make sure all bolts are fastened on both sides and the levers fitted properly before riding. Enjoy the ride!
